PRESENTING RESEARCH



There is a wide range of formats for presenting a research paper. Many organizations provide a template that you should follow.

Below is a general format that you can use. The length of the sections depends on how much time you have for your presentation.

Opening – Create interest

Problem/Issue/Situation - Background

Hypothesis or Hypotheses

Survey / Research Method

Results by Hypothesis

Conclusion

TIPS for Better Research Presentations

- Use an opener that pulls the audience in
- Avoid jargon/acronyms
- Don't over clutter slide with words/data
- If complicated visuals – use animation to build the story and guide viewers' focus
- Show your passion using gestures and engaging vocal variety
- Share your insights along the way:
 - Experiences / Stories
 - Observations / Examples
 - Thinking / Approach

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
